

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Arkansas Department of Health will hold a public hearing on Thursday, September 17, 2015 at 10: 00 a.m. in the Freeway Medical Tower, Room 801, 5800 West 10th Street, Little Rock, Arkansas, to allow interested persons an opportunity to comment on proposed revisions to the *Rules and Regulations for Orthotists, Prosthetists, and Pedorthists Arkansas*.

The revision would allow examinations administered by the Board of Certification (“BOC”) to fulfill examination requirements for licensure in Arkansas; and eliminate Section 8 “Examinations” in its entirety because exam requirements are contained in Section 6, “Qualifications for Licensure”. The proposal also clarifies that licensed orthotic assistants are authorized to assist with pedorthic devices.
