Enclosed is your Arkansas Medical Marijuana Registry ID card. **Please note the start and end dates of your card.** This card is valid from the timeframe specified on the certification form completed by your physician. Visiting patient cards are issued for 90 days.

The Arkansas Department of Health is available to answer questions about your Arkansas Medical Marijuana Registry ID card. We do not provide information regarding physicians who provide certification, legal matters, or the availability of Arkansas Medical Marijuana.

The card renewal process is the same as applying for a new card. You will need to get a **new** physician's written certification signed by a doctor, submit an application, submit a copy of your driver's license or state ID and pay the non-refundable application processing fee. You can submit your renewal application 60 days before the expiration date on your card. You are encouraged to apply early as application processing takes up to 14 days.
