Title: Breast Cancer Module I: Breast Anatomy, Physiology, and Pathology

CE Credits: 1.0

Description: This one hour course will provide an opportunity for the target audience to improve their understanding of breast anatomy, physiology and pathology that is essential for follow-up of abnormal findings. New methods of prognostic factors are described.

Title: Breast Cancer Module II: Health History and Clinical Examination

Pre-requisite: Breast Cancer Module I

Title: Breast Cancer Module III: Workup of Abnormal Clinical Findings

CE Credits: 1.0

Description: This one hour course will improve the clinician's skills in assessing and documenting clinical findings that are suspicious for cancer and essential for timely and appropriate follow-up. Educational information on correlating clinical findings with imaging

findings will assist the target audience in determining the appropriate plan of action to prevent a delayed diagnosis.

Title: Breast Cancer Module IV: Follow-up of Abnormal Imaging Findings

CE Credits: 1.0

Description: This one hour course will assist clinicians in better understanding breast imaging findings to be able to determine concordance with clinical findings.

Pre-requisite: Breast Cancer Module III

Title: Breast Cancer Module V: Risk Management

CE Credits: 1.25

Description: This course addresses risk management strategies that can be utilized to avoid a missed or delayed diagnosis

Pre-requisite: Breast Cancer Module IV
