The meeting was called to order by Vice-Chair, Bret Stone.

Marquita Little gave a brief update on those particular components of legislation or pieces of legislation that have some relevance to child health and to CHAC in particular.

Next steps discussion—CHAC will continue to monitor and evaluate the BMI data collection, what that collection looks like, and the interpretation of the results. Some ideas were about communication and the letter that goes home to parents. It was decided to take another look at the parent letter and think about revising. The first letters went out in 2004 and have not undergone any significant revision since that time. It was suggested we might consider an all-inclusive child health report including all screenings done at school

Next month (May) nominations for Chair for CHAC and for the Vice-Chair will be taken. Voting will occur in June with new terms beginning July.

The legislative report for CHAC is due in July but is due at ADE in June. They come to the Board of Education first.
