Bobbi Helton, Administrator & Pam Byrd D.O.N. @ Brook Ridge Cove Rehabilitation and Care Center. <p style="text-align: center;">SNS FULL SCALE EXERCISE</p> <p>This full scale statewide exercise will test the pipeline for transporting medical countermeasure materials (MCM) from the State level to the County level. Your participation in this exercise is crucial to ensuring that our plans are realistic and attainable. This full scale exercise will also bring faults and shortcomings to light which will enable us to focus on correcting these issues.</p> <p>Exercise will kick off on Wednesday July 29th at 8:00am. State health will issue out a MAC channel for purposes of this exercise. Once they have released this information, I will promptly email the assigned MAC channel to all administrators along with the Regional Director and Regional Administrative Manager. If you have any trouble getting your radio set, please call me at 479-747-8650 and I will assist you. AWIN Radio checks will be conducted for the North West Regional Area (southern counties) from 10am to 11am. I will contact each county via AWIN during that time. Once all 10 of the southern counties have successfully completed radio checks, no further action will be needed on Wednesday.</p> <p>On Thursday, July 30th, the full scale exercise will resume. Arkansas Department of Highway and Transportation (ADHT) will roll out with dummy MCM 8”X10” boxes from the warehouse at approximately 8am. ADHT along with Arkansas State Police (ASP) will deliver these boxes to our counties Regional Distribution sites (troop J and H). I will notify each county once MCM is in route with an ETA to the RDS. Each county will need to have a representative at the RDS site before ADHT and ASP arrive with the MCM. There will be one box for each county, and it will be identified with a white sticker. If there are any closed POD partners that have asked to participate in this exercise, they too will also have an 8X10 box and it will be identified with a colored label. Once ADHT and ASP arrive, the county must obtain their box and any closed POD boxes for their county and transport them back to the LHU. On each sticker, there will be a code word in the “notes” section. Once MCM boxes are transported to the LHU, the administrator will then contact State Health via AWIN radio and use the following scripting:</p> <p>LHU packages – “This message is for exercise purposes only. State Health, this is BLANK county. MCM package has been received for the SNS full scale exercise, and the code word is BLANK.”</p> <p>For Closed POD packages, administrators will contact the closed POD participant once the package has been received at the LHU and is available for pickup. Once the partner shows up to pick up the package, the LHU will contact State Health via AWIN to notify them of delivery:</p> <p>Closed POD packages – “This message is intended for exercise purposes only. State Health, this is BLANK county calling on behalf of CLOSED POD PARTICIPANT.” MCM package has been picked up by CLOSED POD PARTICIPANT for the SNS full scale exercise, and the code word is BLANK.”</p> <p>If the closed POD does not pick up their package by 4pm, the LHU will need to contact State Health via AWIN with the following message:</p> <p>“This message is intended for exercise purposes only. State health, this is BLANK county. MCM package for CLOSED POD PARTICIPANT was received at LHU and participant was notified.</p>

		<p>However participant was unable to pick up MCM. The code word is BLANK.”</p> <p>Once all packages have been delivered to LHU and State Health has been notified of the code word, the administrator’s role of the exercise is complete. There will be a sign in sheet that I will need all participants of the exercise (administrators, OEM, County Officials) to sign. I plan to be at both Troops to obtain signatures, but if I am unable to make both, I will email the sign in sheet for you to sign and return to me. I will be at the Regional Administrators Meeting on the 31st and I will solicit you all for comments and critique. I urge you to provide any concerns your county had with the exercise so those issues can be addressed and mitigated. There will be an AAR conducted on Friday, July 31st, and your input will be used.</p> <p>Thank you all for your participation in this exercise.
