

EMS Trauma Subcommittee
Meeting Summary
January 10th, 2012 - 3:00 PM

The EMS Trauma Subcommittee met on January 10th at 1500. There were 17 people in attendance, with 6 people on the conference call.

The cost estimate for placing AWINS in 33 helicopters remains around 2.8 million. There will be a committee to discuss this and either justify this expense or suggest alternatives.

Greg reported EMS data submission continues to improve. There were 302 K submissions so far for 2011, and he estimates the final number will be around 350 K. The deadline for submission of all 2011 run data is specified as March 31st, 2012 in the trauma deliverables. However, Greg notes EMS has imposed a different deadline, and they are asking all data to be submitted by January 31st. As we move forward, we would like to shorten the timeframe for submitting data. This will likely be changed to the last day of the month following the month in which the call was done.

KC updated us on the NHTSA assessment. The ACS reviewers recommended we pursue this assessment. The last time one was performed was in the 80's. KC has contact information for this program. It will likely take up to two years to schedule this. The estimated cost for the assessment will be around \$30,000.

The bylaws are being reviewed by the Health Dept lawyers. We will move forward with seeking TAC and GAC approval if these are cleared by the attorney.

There was again considerable discussion about PI filters. Greg provided us with a list of what data points he can extract from the state data. We went over each of the items on the list previously prepared by Myra. There was some concern about using arbitrary numbers such as 20 minute scene times. Instead, we would like to report the time interval data as averages. We should have a final draft for review at the next meeting.

We again reviewed the costing proposal Myra worked on. We had decided it would be best to have a voluntary sample to obtain this data, and not to incorporate this as a deliverable. We will have to discuss this at the next Finance subcommittee meeting to ensure this satisfies their goals.

We reviewed the funding formula for the FY 2013 budget. We decided to keep the funding formula the same this year. We will review the deliverables at a future meeting.
