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The Section of Emergency Medical Services & Trauma Systems (Section) will host an informational session related to Emergency Management Assistant Compacts (EMAC) on **Wednesday, May 13, 2009 from 1:00 p.m. to 4 p.m.** This meeting will be held in the Arkansas Department of Health Auditorium, 4815 West Markham Street, Little Rock, Arkansas. During the meeting, staff from the Arkansas Department of Emergency Management and Section will discuss history of EMAC guidelines related to ambulance service reimbursement, FEMA cost code schedule, and future EMAC out-of-state ambulance deployments. This session is designed for ambulance service owners, operators, and supervisors.
