

TBI HOSPITALIZATIONS CHILDREN AGES 0-4 FACT SHEET



From 2000 through 2006 a total of 665 children ages 0-4 were discharged from Arkansas hospitals with Traumatic Brain Injuries. Between 74 and 115 hospitalizations occurred annually, an average 95 of children per year. ¹



The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention estimate that 37,000 children ages 0-14 receive brain injuries severe enough to require hospitalization each year. ²
