Run reports for who did not pick up and who did not get recertified and contact those folks. Consistently schedule high risk and nutrition education classes. Almost always, pickup is the same day as the appointment. If you can get them to attend the appointment, they will also pick up checks. Remind clients of those appointments (per policy). The last time a participant picks up checks before the certification ends, actually schedule the certification The last time a participant picks up checks before the certification ends, actually schedule the certification appointment, rather than telling them to

	<p>call back to schedule the appointment. Call the day before to remind participants of recert appointments, high risk, and nutrition education classes. Call all your no shows for certification and offer to reschedule. Try to issue 3 months of checks if at all possible. If a participant is not high risk, issue 3 months of checks at certification, then schedule nutrition education class at the next pick up. <u>You still have to keep foster children, special formula, and breastfeeding pairs for the first 3 months on monthly issuance.</u> If a participant cannot come in to pick up (for instance, no transportation), policy says you can mail 1 month of checks. You need to make a general note about who asked you to mail, why, that you verified the address, and that you advised them checks won't be replaced if lost in the mail.</p> <p>Look closely at what might make people want to stay away, such as customer service and wait times. WIC participants are our customers— please treat them the way you would want to be treated. Jaynie Jones spoke with Jane Johnson, We need more time for WIC appointments. We have a high demand for WIC and I know we can get WIC numbers up. Looking at the schedule on Mondays and Thursdays for this month (NP day) we have averaged productivity for 1 nurse. I would like for you to consider other options for Mondays for NP day. So we will have more time for WIC. Please talk this over with Jan, Barbara, and/or Don. Let me know your recommendations. Barbara and I have discussed this and recommend that you schedule 15-16 patients on Mondays and have a one nurse NP Clinic. The other nurse can then be scheduled a full WIC schedule. This will help you stay in compliance with WIC processing standards and increase your WIC caseload. Continue to have a full schedule for 2 nurses on the Thursday NP Clinics. We need to closely monitor the Monday clinics and if the demand increases we may need to resume a 2 nurse schedule. If you have any questions, please call Barbara or me. Thanks. Jane</p>
