Community Health Centers (CHCs) strive to ensure everyone has access to **local, affordable, high quality** health care. CHCs' emphasis on quality is evident by the focus on achieving

The CHCs provide local patient-centered, accessible, coordinated care through a team-based approach stressing quality and safety.


