## STEAD SCHOLARS INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

Who: All Arkansas undergraduates enrolled in accredited four-year colleges and universities in

the state are eligible to apply.

Where: Arkansas Department of Health (ADH) and UAMS Fay W Boozman College of Public

Health (COPH)

**Details:** This full-time program gives students an introduction to public health, exposure to applied

and basic public health science and practice, and health policy development.

Interns will spend eight weeks (June 3 to July 26) at the ADH's Central Office and the UAMS COPH in Little Rock. They will be assigned a senior staff or faculty member as a

mentor and will complete a research project under the mentor's supervision.

Each awardee will receive a stipend of \$4,000. Limited housing through UAMS may also be

available for those living more than 50 miles from Little Rock.
