

Arkansas' Seven (7) Stroke Regions




All AR Regions - EMS Pre-Notification April 2023 - June 2023



All Regions: Stroke Band ID Documented




All AR Regions - Stroke Bands Documented April 2023 - June 2023



All Regions: Door to CT Within 25 Minutes








AR Valley Region - Stroke Band ID Documented April 2023 - June 2023
