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COVID 19 Doses Administered by the Health Equity Strike Team: National Family Pharmacy Single Booster Dose Vaccination Clinic Total: 160 Single Booster Doses (Pfizer)

On Wednesday November 17, 2021, the Health Equity Strike Team partnered with National Family Pharmacy to hold a single booster dose vaccination clinic in Ft. Smith, AR. **Those eligible to be vaccinated included eligible individuals that have completed the primary Pfizer two-dose vaccine series.** The breakdown of vaccinations by race/ethnicity was as follows: Black or African American, 36 (23%); White 78 (49%); Asian, 9 (6%); American Indian 2 (1%) and Other, 35 (21%). The breakdown of vaccinations by ethnicity was: Non-Hispanic, 124 (78%) and Hispanic 36 (22%). In add

The clinic was held at 55 South 7th Street, Ft. Smith from 3:00 p.m.- 6:00 p.m. Community organizers included Mayor George McGill, Jurena Storm, Jeff Fenwick (Pharmacist) and the local Fire Department. Strike Team members included: Clifford Allen, Debra Joyner and Deborah Dawson. A total of 10 lottery ticket scratch-off cards and 10 Game and Fish Certificates were distributed. In addition to COVID vaccinations, 27 flu shots were administered using doses provided by the ADH-Immunization and Outbreak Control Branch.
