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COVID 19 Doses Administered by the Health Equity Strike Team: D&D Pharmacy Single Booster Dose Vaccination Clinic Total: 11 Single Booster Doses (Pfizer)

On Wednesday October 6, 2021, the Health Equity Strike Team partnered with D & D Pharmacy to hold a single booster dose vaccination clinic in Little Rock, AR. **Those eligible to be vaccinated included individuals that completed the primary Pfizer two-dose vaccine series on 1/22/2021 and 2/25/2021 respectively.** The breakdown of vaccinations by race/ethnicity was as follows: Black or African American, 9 (82%); White, 1 (9%); and Other, 1 (9%). The breakdown of vaccinations by ethnicity was: Non-Hispanic, 10 (91%) and Hispanic, 1 (9%).

The clinic was held at D & D Pharmacy on 8908 Kanis Road Suite 359, in Little Rock from 9:00 a.m.- 12:00 p.m. Community organizers included: Capt Michelle R Smith and Marlene Battle. Strike Team members included: Debra Joyner and Aiyana Billings. Black Swan Catering provided lunches for the first **30** individuals to get vaccinated. A total of 9 lottery ticket scratch-off cards were distributed.
