COVID 19 Doses Administered by the Health Equity Strike Team: D&D Pharmacy Single Booster Dose Vaccination Clinic Total: 52 Single Booster Doses (Pfizer)

On Wednesday October 27, 2021, the Health Equity Strike Team partnered with Partners for Inclusive Communities and D&D Pharmacy to hold a single booster dose vaccination clinic in North Little Rock, AR. **Those eligible to be vaccinated included individuals that have completed the primary Pfizer two-dose vaccine series.** The breakdown of vaccinations by race/ethnicity was as follows: Black or African American, 42 (81%) and White, 10 (19%). The breakdown of vaccinations by ethnicity was: Non-Hispanic, 52 (100%).

The clinic was held at Arkansas Enterprise for the Developmentally Disabled (AEDD) on 1802 Franklin Street, North Little Rock from 10:00 a.m.- 1:00 p.m. Community organizers included: Gabrielle Ross Jayme Womack. Strike Team members included Deborah Joyner, Aiyana Billings, and Shaina Steverson. A total of 32 lottery ticket scratch-off cards were distributed.
