## COVID 19 Doses Administered by the Health Equity Strike Team:

### Bobby G Lester Elementary Pediatric Vaccination Clinic

**Total: 99 Total Doses | 35 Boosters, 58 Pediatric First Dose, and 6 Adult First Dose**

On Friday, Nov 19, 2021, the Health Equity Strike Team collaborated with Bobby G Lester Elementary School to hold a pediatric dose vaccination clinic in Jacksonville. **Those eligible to be vaccinated included individuals 5 years of age or older.** The breakdown of vaccinations by race/ethnicity was as follows: White, 60 (61%), Black or African American, 33 (33%); Asian, 1 (1%) and Other Race, 4 (4%). The breakdown of vaccinations by ethnicity was: Non-Hispanic, 96 (97%) and Hispanic 2 (2%).

The clinic was held at **Bobby G Lester Elementary (Gym)**, 601 Harris Road in Jacksonville from 4:30PM-7PM. Community organizers included: Dr. Jeremy Owoh (Principal) and Terry Perkins (Pharmacist). The Strike Team members included: Marcus McClendon (Lead), Shaina Steverson and Aiyana Billings.
