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COVID 19 Doses Administered by the Health Equity Strike Team: Total: 91 Single Booster Doses (Pfizer)

On Monday, October 4, 2021, the Health Equity Strike Team partnered with Kavanaugh Pharmacy to hold a single booster dose vaccination clinic in Little Rock, AR. **Those eligible to be vaccinated included individuals that have completed the primary Pfizer two-dose vaccine series.** The breakdown of vaccinations by race/ethnicity was as follows: Black or African American, 5 (5%); White, 81 (90%); Asian, 3 (3%) and Other, 2 (2%). The breakdown of vaccinations by ethnicity was: Non-Hispanic, 89 (98%) and Hispanic, 2 (2%).

The clinic was held at Kavanaugh Pharmacy on 5705 Kavanaugh BLVD in Little Rock from 3:00 p.m.-6:00 p.m. Strike Team members included: Aiyana Billings, Esmeralda Pena, and James Cain. Black Swan Catering provided lunches for the first **30** individuals to get vaccinated. A total of 30 lottery ticket scratch-off cards and 1 Game and Fish Certificate were distributed.
