BONNIE SUE HOWE SEISER, LICENSE NO. R050751

Respondent was present for the proceedings before the Board and was represented by counsel, Stewart Whaley. Lisa Wooten, MPH, BSN, RN, and Terry Kuykendall, Investigator, provided testimony on behalf of the Board. Wade Seiser provided testimony on behalf of the Respondent. Respondent has been charged with Ark. Code Ann. § 17-87-309(a)(6) and pleads not guilty to the charges. While employed at Physicians' Specialty Hospital, Respondent submitted a random drug screen on August 9, 2021, and tested positive for benzodiazepines at 242 ng/ml, for which she had no valid prescription. Respondent was terminated from employment. Respondent provided a written statement to the investigator wherein she admits the allegations of the positive drug screen. Respondent explained that she was sick with Rocky Mountain Spotted Fever and asked her husband to bring her an alprazolam, which she has a prescription for. The Respondent stated her husband thinks he brought her the wrong tablet. Respondent provided a copy of a pharmacy prescription profile for her husband. Wade Seiser. A prescription for 30 mg. capsules of temazepam was filled for Mr. Seiser on July 12, 2021. Board staff offered Respondent a consent agreement for one (1) year of probation with monitoring, for violation of A.C.A. §17-87-309 (a)(6), and the Arkansas State Board of Nursing Rules, Chapter Seven., Section IV (A)(6)(p). Respondent declined the offered consent agreement. Respondent's legal counsel requested a hearing before the Board.

MOTION: I MOVE that based on the evidence presented and the allegations contained in the Order and Notice of Hearing, the Arkansas State Board of Nursing finds that **BONNIE SUE HOWE SEISER, LICENSE NO. R050751,** has been charged with a violation of Ark. Code Ann. § 17-87-309(a)(6) and the Arkansas State Board of Nursing *Rules*, Chapter Seven, Section IV (A)(6)(p), and that a Letter of Reprimand be issued.
