

WHY SHOULD YOU GET A Vaccine?

COVID-19 VACCINES PROTECT YOU FROM GETTING VERY SICK

All of the COVID-19 vaccines are nearly 100% effective at keeping someone out of the hospital or keeping them from dying from COVID-19. If you are vaccinated, there is still a small chance you may have symptoms of COVID-19, but the vaccine will keep those symptoms from becoming severe.

THE VACCINES HAVE BEEN STUDIED BY A DIVERSE GROUP OF THE UNITED STATES' TOP SCIENTISTS AND DOCTORS

No corners were cut in the testing of vaccines. The vaccines were able to be produced quickly because all the usual red tape and financial barriers were taken away.

THE COVID-19 VACCINES HAVE BEEN PROVEN TO BE SAFE

Side effects like a sore arm or mild symptoms are normal and expected after you get a vaccine. More serious side effects are very rare and extremely unlikely. You are much more likely to have major complications from COVID-19 infection than from the vaccines.

These vaccines cannot give you COVID-19 because none of the vaccines authorized in the United States contain a live virus. COVID-19 vaccines will not affect your fertility. COVID-19 vaccines do not change or interact with your DNA in any way.

You should still get vaccinated even if you have already had COVID-19. Studies have shown that vaccination provides a strong boost in protection in people who have recovered from COVID-19. It is important to get both doses if you get the Pfizer or Moderna vaccine.

- Does NOT contain eggs, preservatives, latex, metals

JOHNSON & JOHNSON

- 1 shot
- Viral vector technology
- Recommended for people 18 years of age and older
- Does NOT contain eggs, preservatives, latex, metals
