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COVID 19 Doses Administered by the Health Equity Strike Team: Cornerstone Pharmacy Single Booster Dose Vaccination Clinic Total: 20 Single Booster Doses (Pfizer)

On Friday October 8, 2021, the Health Equity Strike Team partnered with Cornerstone Pharmacy to hold a single booster dose vaccination clinic in North Little Rock, AR. **Those eligible to be vaccinated included eligible individuals that have completed the primary Pfizer two-dose vaccine series.** The breakdown of vaccinations by race/ethnicity was as follows: Black or African American, 20 (100%). The breakdown of vaccinations by ethnicity was: Non-Hispanic, 20 (100%).

The clinic was held at Cornerstone Pharmacy on 4307 E Broadway, North Little Rock from 9:00 a.m.- 12:00 p.m. Community organizers included the Little Rock Panhellenic Chapter and Randy Kassissieh (Pharmacist). Strike Team members included: Esmerelda Pena and Aiyana Billings. Black Swan Catering provided lunches for the first 15 individuals to get vaccinated. A total of 16 lottery ticket scratch-off cards were distributed.
