

Summary of Pertaining to Milk Bank Standards

Act 216 of 2019 required the Arkansas Department of Health (ADH) to establish by rule, standards for transporting, processing, and distributing commercial human breast milk on a for-profit or nonprofit basis. ADH developed the Standards based on the nationally recognized Human Milk Banking Association of North America's Standards.

ADH Standards address issues of Public Health concerns regarding Human Milk, such as Donor Screening, Serological Tests, Equipment, Temperature, and Lab Standards.
