#### **PREFACE**

This report is based on information obtained by licensing boards during the 2022 license renewal process. Copies of practitioner responses to questions on license renewal applications were provided to the Arkansas Department of Health (ADH) Health Statistics Branch by the licensing boards. Because the data were collected by several boards using questionnaires designed to meet the licensing requirements of the individual professions, a certain consistency of format and content, desirable for manpower measurement, is missing from the data. Various items of demographic data, such as ethnic origin and gender, are obtained by some, but not all, of the boards. Information relating to a practitioner's location- address, city, county, state, etc.- meets the licensing board's need to communicate with the practitioner by mail and may or may not identify the site(s) where health-related services are performed.

The report includes tables, maps and graphs representing health professions manpower distribution and demographics in Arkansas counties. The 2010 Census from the U.S. Census Bureau, Population Division, was used in the computation of population ratios throughout this report.

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**Acknowledgement:** We wish to express our gratitude to the licensing boards of these professions for their cooperation in providing requested access to their license-renewal files.





#### **Health Professionals in Arkansas**

In 2022, there were 94,701 licensed health professionals with Arkansas mailing addresses serving 3 million Arkansans, a population ratio of 310.9 professionals for every 10,000-population living in the State. There were 16 professions administered by 12 boards. The largest registration was by the Arkansas State Board of Nursing with 57,468 licensees, followed by the Arkansas State Medical Board with 13,132 licensees. The smallest registration was by the Arkansas Board of Podiatric Medicine with 84 licensees. As a group, health professionals were distributed evenly across the counties with a heavier concentration in counties with larger populations.

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

# **Chiropractors in Arkansas**


In 2022, the Board of Chiropractic Examiners licensed 599 chiropractors with mailing addresses in Arkansas: about 2 per 10,000 population. Of the 75 counties in Arkansas, 18 counties (24%) had no registered chiropractors and 15 other counties (20%) had only one.

# Chiropractors by Counties Per 10,000 Population





#### **Dental Health Professionals in Arkansas**

In 2022, the Board of Dental Examiners licensed 7,228 professionals of dental health services with mailing addresses in Arkansas: about 23.2 per 10,000 population. This total includes 1,576 dentists (DD), 3,847 dental assistants (DA), and 1,805 dental hygienists (DH). Overall, the number of dental health professionals decreased by 0.7 % for the state. There was an increase in DDs of 17.2 %, an increase in DHs by 5%, and a decrease in DAs by 8.7%. Each of the 75 counties in Arkansas had at least three registered dental health professionals, though it should be noted that dental assistants are included but have a limited scope of practice. Later in this section we will provide information on those considered primary care oral health providers only.


## Dental Health Professionals by Counties Per 10,000 Population




#### Distribution of Dental Professionals by Region

#### **Distribution of Dental Professionals by Specialty**





The following graph shows that the gender distribution of licensed dentists is heavily skewed for males (66%) with only 34% of Arkansas dentists being female. However, the gender distribution of licensed dental hygienists is heavily skewed for females (>99%) with <1% being males. Gender was not received for dental assistants.








In 2022, the Medical Board licensed 13, 132 health professionals with mailing addresses in Arkansas. The 2022 registry includes 4,422 physicians (34%) registered in five primary care specialties with mailing addresses in Arkansas; about 14.5 per 10,000 population. This list includes: 1,652 family practice, 75 general practice, 1,621 internal medicine, 345 obstetrics-gynecologists (OB/GYN), and 729 pediatrics. At least one fully licensed primary care physician was registered in each Arkansas county. The board licensed 3,114 physicians as secondary specialists and 8 physicians who reported no specialty. Also, the board licensed 5,588 health professionals as Health-Related Professionals. This total is made up of 1,887 Respiratory Therapists (LRCP), 1,793 Occupational Therapists (OT), 1,048 Occupational Therapy Assistants (OT-A), 610 Physician Assistants (PA), 5 Radiologist Assistants (RA), 3 Radiology Practitioner Assistants (RPA), 223 Surgical Technologists (ST), and 19 Licensed Genetic Counselors (LGC).

### Primary Care Physicians by County Per 10,000 Population




Distribution of Primary Care Physicians by Region



**Distribution of Primary Care Physicians by Specialty** 




# **Primary Care Physicians by Region and Specialty**

# **Primary Care Physicians by Gender and Specialty**






# Family Practice Physicians by County Per 10,000 Population




#### General Practice Physicians by County Per 10,000 Population




## Internal Medicine Physicians by County Per 10,000 Population








**Health-Related Professionals by Region** 






# **Health-Related Professionals by Region and Specialty**



#### **Nurses in Arkansas**

In 2022, the Nursing Board licensed 57,468 nurses with mailing addresses in Arkansas, about 188.7 per 10,000 population. This total includes 39,104 Registered Nurses (RN), 12,958 Licensed Practical Nurses (LPN), 39 Licensed Psychiatric Technician Nurses (LPTN), and 233 Registered Nurse Practitioners (RNP). There were 5,134 nurses registered as Advanced Practice Nurses (APN). These 57,468 nurses had a total of 63,597 licenses, however for the purposes of this report, the following hierarchy was used to take the highest of the five license types: LPN < LPTN < RN < RNP < APN. The APNs consist of four different licenses but will be grouped together for most of this section. They will be broken down into individual licenses later in the section. The number of licensed nurses for the state increased 2.4% from 2021 to 2022.


After completing basic nursing programs, RN and LPN must pass nationally standardized examinations. LPTNs must have passed a state licensure exam. RNPs must complete a nurse practitioner program in addition to their RN program. To be licensed as an APN, an RN must complete an advanced practice nursing program and hold certification from a Board approved, nationally recognized, certifying body.

### Nurses by County Per 10,000 Population




Distribution of Nurses by Region



**Distribution of Nurses by Title** 








At this point in the section, the Advanced Practice Nurse group will be broken down into individual license types. The four licenses in this category are: Certified Nurse Midwife (CNM), Clinical Nurse Specialist (CNS), Certified Registered Nurse Anesthetist (CNRA), and Certified Nurse Practitioner (CNP). Certified Nurse Practitioner has replaced the term Advanced Nurse Practitioner (ANP). These four licenses are considered equal in educational requirements so there is not a hierarchy for this group. Since they are considered equal, the nurses that have more than one APN license will be counted in the analysis for each license that they have.

There are 5,134 Advanced Practice Nurses with a total of 5,154 licenses. This total includes 4,273 Certified Nurse Practitioners (CNP), 33 Certified Nurse Midwives (CNM), 134 Clinical Nurse Specialists (CNS), and 714 Certified Registered Nurse Anesthetists (CRNA).



# **Optometry in Arkansas**



# Optometrists by County Per 10,000 Population







## Pharmacists by County Per 10,000 Population



# **Physical Therapists in Arkansas**



## Physical Therapists by County Per 10,000 Population






Physical Therapists by Region




**Physical Therapist Assistants by Region**





# Podiatrists by County Per 10,000 Population







### Pscyhologists by County Per 10,000 Population




Distribution of Psychologists by Region



Distribution of Psychologists by Title




# Psychologists by Region and License Type



#### **Social Workers in Arkansas**


In 2022, the Social Work Licensing Board licensed 3,479 social workers with mailing addresses in Arkansas: about 11 per 10,000 population. This total includes 336 social workers (LSW), 1,976 certified social workers (LCSW), and 1,022 master social workers (LMSW). In addition, the Social Worker Licensing Board issued 145 provisional licenses for social workers with mailing addresses in Arkansas (*Provisional license for social workers means: First-time applicants for LSW or LMSW licensure will be issued a provisional license upon approval of his or her application. A provisional license will be issued one time per person and expires exactly one year from the date of issuance. Provisional licensing is prohibited at the LCSW level.). This total includes 41 Provisional license social workers (PLSW), and 104 provisional license master social workers (PLMSW). At least one fully licensed social worker was licensed in each of the Arkansas counties.* 

### Social Workers by County Per 10,000 Population




Distribution of Social Workers by Region











## Veterinarians by County Per 10,000 Population


