

What are dental sealants?

A dental sealant is a thin, clear plastic coating that is brushed onto the surface of your child's teeth.

Why should my child get dental sealants?

- **Dental sealants** help prevent cavities in the back teeth (molars).
- Without sealants, children have almost 3 times more molar cavities than children with sealants.
- Sealants, are quick, easy, and last a long time.



- Who? Children between 6 and 14 years old
- When? As soon as their permanent molars start to show
- How long do they last? Sealants last for many years and can be replaced
