URINE ADULTERANT LIST

In compliance with Act 750 of 2003, the Arkansas Department of Health lists substances that might be used to adulterate urine or other bodily fluid samples with the intent to defraud or cause deceitful results in a drug or alcohol screening test. These are substances that are not expected to be present in human urine, or if present, are at a concentration so high, it is not consistent with human urine. The list includes, but is not limited to:

- (1) Bleach;
- (2) Chromium;
- (3) Creatinine;
- (4) Detergent;
- (5) Glutaraldehyde;
- (6) Glutaraldehyde/squalene;
- (7) Hydrochloric acid;
- (8) Hydriodic acid;
- (9) Iodine;
- (10) Nitrite;
- (11) Peroxidase;
- (12) Potassium dichromate;
- (13) Potassium nitrite;
- (14) Pyridinium chlorochromate; and
- (15) Sodium nitrite.
